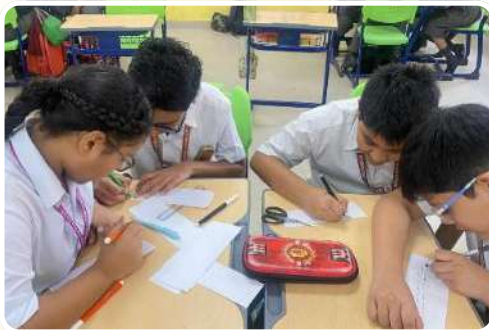
Independence Day

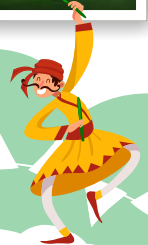


Janmashtami

WORLD LITERACY DAY

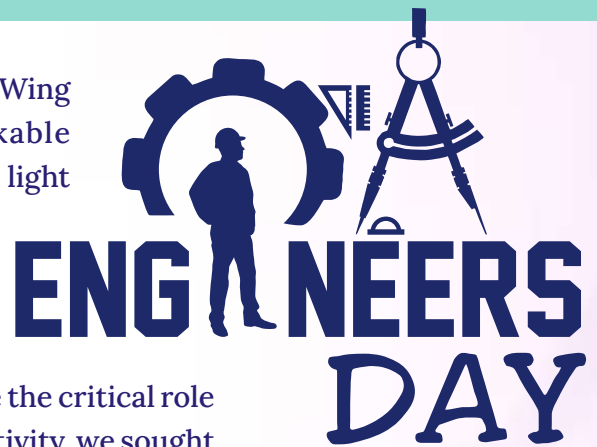
