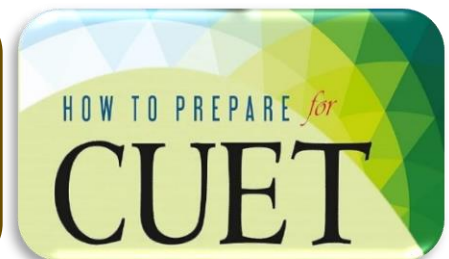
**Psychometric Assessments** – These tests help students gain insights into their strengths, weaknesses, interests, and abilities. **Entrance exam preparation** - The Common University Entrance Test (CUET) is a nationally recognized examination that evaluates a student's academic aptitude, critical thinking skills, and subject knowledge. It serves as an essential gateway for admission into various renowned universities and institutes across the country. We have introduced in-house classes to prepare students for this exam, which will cover the CUET syllabus and exam pattern. We aim to equip them with the necessary skills and knowledge to excel in this competitive examination.
