



Internships in June 2024

As part of our profile-building activities, our Counseling Cell organized internships for students across various industries and professions to provide practical experience, career insights, and essential skill development for their future success in higher education and the professional world.

IPEC- A two-week Summer Internship Program was jointly organized by Inderprastha Engineering College, Ghaziabad, under the banner of IPEC-TBI, a MoMSME approved business incubator, and IPEC Institute Innovation Council, approved by the Ministry of Education Innovation Cell. The program took place from June 18th to June 29th in a hybrid mode and was designed for students in classes IX, X, XI, and XII. 74 students from our school participated in this program. The program was curated to equip students with awareness of various technologies, their scope for innovation, management skills including leadership and team building, and knowledge in innovation & entrepreneurship through Design Thinking, Creative Thinking, Ideation, and Intellectual Property Rights.





Bennett University

From June 5th to 7th, 18 students undertook a three-day internship at Bennett University, Greater Noida, focused on 'New Age Technologies and Business Intelligence'. They gained hands-on experience in AI, robotics, mechanical, aerospace, and electronics, alongside startup insights. The program also included campus exploration and sports activities, preparing students for college life and fostering practical and entrepreneurial skills.

IISER - IISER Bhopal hosted a summer camp from May 6-11, 2024, at their Bhauri Bhopal campus for students in grades IX-XI. Vidisha Chauhan from class XII was selected for this program. The camp focused on showcasing the societal impact of science, blending natural and engineering sciences with insights from Humanities and Social Sciences. It featured lectures, lab sessions, and interactive activities with senior students, fostering a holistic learning experience.



HDFC

Grade 12 students from Seth Anandram Jaipuria School, Vasundhara, participated in a two-day internship at HDFC Bank. They learned about everyday banking and common frauds from experienced professionals. The program enhanced their understanding of banking operations and financial safety, preparing them for responsible financial management.

FORTIS HOSPITAL

Fortis Hospital, Noida hosted a week-long offline psychology internship for grade XII students from Delhi NCR schools. 23 students studying Psychology from Seth Anandram Jaipuria School participated in this program, from June 17 to 22, 2024, gaining insights into psychiatric ward processes. They learned about common public concerns, psychotherapies, techniques, and their implications, expressing eagerness for future opportunities.
