Kindly Note:

- Annual Exam (Grade IX& XI) and Board Exam (Grade X & XII) will cover the whole syllabus in all the subjects.
- Promotion is granted on the basis of the performance of the student during the entire session.
- For grades VI-IX and XI, the students must secure 33 % marks in internal as well as Term exams for promotion to the next grade.
- A student must secure at least 33% in all the subjects individually and in aggregate in theory as well as practical subjects separately for fulfilling the pass criteria.
- In case the student has secured less than 33% in one subject only and 33% and more in all other subjects in theory and practical examination separately, the student will be eligible for 'Retest'.
- In case the student has secured less than 33% in two or more subjects, he/she will not be eligible for 'Supplementary' Examination and will be detained in the same grade.
- The student must get a minimum 'C' grade in Work Education.
- The Student must have a minimum of 75% attendance to be eligible to appear in Final the Examination.
- It is mandatory for the student to appear in Periodic Tests, Pre-board and Term End Examination.
- No retest of any kind will be conducted if a student is absent on the day of examination.
- If any exam is postponed / preponed, it is mandatory for all to abide by school instructions. No application for a retest / re-exam will be entertained.
- The Medical certificate in case of medical leave should be submitted to the class teacher within two days of commencement of exam.
- If a scribe is required in case of emergency a prior permission at least three days before the exam should be taken.
- A student who fails in a grade for two successive years or fails twice in three years will have to be withdrawn from the school
