Two-Day Internship Program

Our school collaborated with Jaipuria Institute of Management (JIM) to conduct a Two-Day Internship Program for Class XII students on 6th and 7th March, 2025. Held at the JIM campus, the program was led by industry experts and covered key areas such as Cyber Security, Career Awareness, Design Thinking, Domain Awareness in MBA and Engineering fields, and Startup as a Career. Students gained practical insights into emerging career paths, problem-solving techniques, and the entrepreneurial process. The program proved to be an enriching experience, helping students make informed choices about their future careers.

Student Visit to Amity University – A Learning Experience

On March 18, 2025, Humanities students from Seth Anandram Jaipuria School visited Amity University for an enriching educational experience. They explored the Amity School of Communication, gaining hands-on exposure to media facilities like the TV newsroom and editing suites. A session on Power BI made data analysis engaging, while a game on "higher risk, higher returns" simplified financial concepts. The visit also included a soft skills workshop focusing on non-verbal communication, first impressions, and time management. It was a well-rounded experience that combined learning with real-world insights.
