COURSE vs CUT-OFF snapshot (2025 1st list)

**Delhi:** 97-99 % (Commerce), 96-98 % (Science), 95-97 % (Arts)

**Mumbai:** 92-96 % (Autonomous), 88-94 % (affiliated)  
Chennai: 95-98 % (Loyola/Stella), 90-94 % (govt quota)

**Kolkata:** 92-96 % (Presidency), 88-93 % (others)

### COUNSELLOR'S TAKE

Pick the STREAM first: Delhi & Chennai colleges dominate pure sciences; Mumbai = commerce + media; Kolkata = cheap, research-heavy.

Use “safety” & “super-reach” ladder: e.g. aspirant with 96 % (CBSE) – super-reach Hindu Physics, target Miranda Physics, safety Kirori Mal. Exploit AUTONOMY: Ruia, Loyola, Presidency set their own papers—easier to score high for masters' entrance. Factor in LIVING COST: Delhi hostel ₹45 k/yr; Mumbai PG ₹15 k/month; Chennai on-campus ₹35 k/yr. Watch NEW age courses: BMS at Xavier's, Data-Science minor at Somaiya, Environmental Science at Miranda—future-proof.

### FICCI Higher Education Summit 2025
