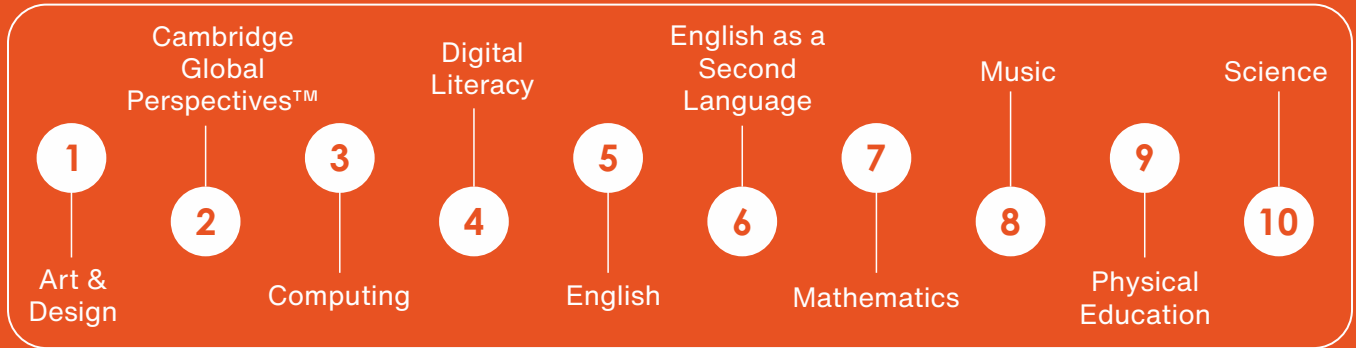

CAMBRIDGE ASSESSMENT

Cambridge Assessments are designed to evaluate and improve a student's learning. Assessments are aimed at accurately measuring a learner's progress and unlock the potential by focusing on areas of strength and improvement. Cambridge assessments also go beyond written tests. They comprise oral tests and listening tests as well. The Cambridge Primary curriculum at Seth Anandram Jaipuria School will assess through **CAMBRIDGE PRIMARY PROGRESSION TESTS**, but students will also have the option of **CAMBRIDGE PRIMARY CHECKPOINT**.



FAQs

1. Do Indian universities recognize Cambridge qualifications?

Nearly all Indian universities with undergraduate programmes recognize Cambridge qualifications. Universities with formal recognition policies include central and state universities, as well as renowned private and deemed universities across the country. Indian higher education institutions recognize Cambridge International A Levels as equivalent to Indian senior secondary qualifications.

2. Will the Cambridge Primary curriculum run concurrently to the CBSE curriculum at school?

Yes, the Cambridge Primary curriculum will run concurrently to the CBSE curriculum at Seth Anandram Jaipuria School.

3. Since the school is introducing Cambridge Primary for classes I to V, can a student join this Cambridge programme at, say, class III or class IV or class V? Or can a student join only at class I?

A student can join the program at any stage.

4. What's the cost differential between the CBSE Curriculum and Cambridge Curriculum?

There is a cost differential which can be discussed in a one-to-one interaction with the admission counselor.

5. Will my ward's school dress and school timings change after opting for Cambridge Primary?

The student's dress and school timings will remain the same.

6. Will students studying in Cambridge Primary have the same books as those in CBSE curriculum?

Students studying Cambridge Primary will have the text books from publishers who are endorsed by CAIE. Books for Hindi will remain the same.
